### Presenter

Terri Jay, Internationally Acclaimed Animal Communicator and Veterinary Intuitive

Terri found out she was intuitive while working with non-verbal disabled children in a horseback therapy program in Reno, Nevada in 1990. This led her to learn animal communication and veterinary intuition, which she has been doing for 20 years.

### Syllabus

Appreciate the balance and the benefits of both allopathic and holistic vet med. We need both holistic and allopathic veterinary medicine to take the best care of our pets. Behavior problems in horses are usually due to them being out of alignment. Chiropractic fixes most problems. It's also essential for dogs to be comfortable if competing and for older pets to maximize their quality of life.

### You are all intuitive!

There are many occasions when you just KNOW what the problem is with a pet without testing or even an exam.

We are all born with 10 senses, 5 physical and 5 spiritual

1. Intuition
2. Clairvoyance – Clear Seeing
3. Clairsentience – Clear Sensing/Feeling
4. Clairaudience – Clear Hearing
5. Claircognizance - Clear Knowing

We turn these abilities off in childhood so we just have to turn them back on.

### How can you learn to open to your intuitive abilities?

We must understand that everything has a vibration. This is Quantum Physics. There are basically two kinds of vibrations – High and Low, Positive and Negative.

Requires feeling, no thinking, just listening and no internal debating.

Grounding with visualization and intention is essential.

No Ego! Ego means “Easing God Out!” Eliminate your need to be right.

Use meditation to raise your own vibration.

Practice – use your intuition on every examination and every case and then prove it out.

### How can you learn to communicate with pets?

They speak with visual images, tastes, feelings, smells and sounds.

It comes through in pulses of information.

It is up to you to put together the meaning.  
The messages will come over the top of your questions. It's instantaneous.  
You can explain things to a pet using meal times and light and dark for days and nights since they don't have a sense of time.  
Explain procedures with feelings – a vaccination could be “A Pinch, No sick!”  
Remember, it is immediately given to you and before you have finished your mental question.

#### The Joy of Euthanasia

We are a 99% spiritual being in a 1% physical body. So are our pets.  
When we leave the physical, we return to pure spirit.  
Pets go to sleep for 10-90 seconds and then pop out of their bodies, do the wet-dog shake and the party is on!  
They act like puppies, kittens and colts.  
My experience has been that they go through you with intense joy on the way out.  
It's so strong it can knock you off your feet.  
They have no connection to their remains once they are out of the physical.  
They return to their homes with their owners and hang around to be with them.

#### Reincarnation

Only one rule – With God (Source) all things are possible.  
All pets will return to you in a shiny new body if you allow it.  
There are no rules about how they will return to you.  
There is regular reincarnation, walk-ins, multiple spirits in one body, one spirit splitting into two or more bodies, etc.  
Find them in their new form by looking with your heart.  
When you pass, they will all be waiting for you, even though they have returned to you many times.

#### Summary

All of you are intuitive and you can also do animal communication.  
Learning it will help you in diagnosing and treating your furry patients.  
Be open to receiving the information and don't analyze it.  
Remember it will come instantly, as you are asking a mental question.  
Pets are into quality of life, not quantity. Help your human clients with this.  
Know that in euthanasia, you are freeing this wonderful being from its painful, worn-out body.  
The pet's spirit can return to its owner in a shiny, new body and make their life a living hell!  
Keep doing all the great work that you do in saving the lives of the animals that mean so much to all of us!
